Funding

Eligibility

- be a current student in a master by coursework program within FEIT with at least one semester remaining in your degree at the time of the planned experience
- be proposing an experience which does not directly contribute to course credit or assessment.
- submit a risk assessment for the intended experience and/or travel
- have not have previously received an Enrichment Grant.
