Two scholarships of \$20,000 each are available. Each scholarship will be paid across biannual instalments for a period of two years after course commencement in 2027.

- be an Australian citizen or permanent resident
- intend to commence the University of Melbourne [Master of Chemical Engineering](#) in either the start- or mid-year intake in 2027

 - your interest and study/career aspirations in the chemical engineering discipline
 - the proposed impact the scholarship will have
